

# Sea City Work Camp “ADULT” Tool & Gear List

Please put your name on **EVERYTHING** you bring to camp. You may want to use fluorescent tape or paint so you can easily identify your tools.

## **Bucket or toolbox to carry your tools to & from work site**

- hammer (recommend a 16 oz claw)
- nail apron
- pry bar
- utility shears
- work gloves
- paint brushes (2) 2” for trim, (2) 4” for walls
- paint roller frame
- empty coffee cans for painting or roofing nails
- putty knife
- pliers
- crescent wrench
- tape measure (at least 12 foot)
- screw drivers – 1 flat & 1 Phillips
- 2 pencils
- safety glasses
- 2 dust masks
- personalized drinking cup or sports bottle
- hack saw
- cordless drill/screwdriver
- corded drill
- 2 heavy duty extension cords (25’)
- outlet strip
- portable sawhorses
- knee pads
- chalk line
- caulk gun

## Additional items for roofing

- circular saw
- jig saw
- carpenters squares - small and large
- reciprocating saw (saws all)
- tin snips

- \_\_\_ at least one throw away outfit for painting
- \_\_\_ throw away outfit for mud bowl
- \_\_\_ cot or air mattress with sleeping gear & pillow
- \_\_\_ towels & wash cloths for 5 days
- \_\_\_ personalized drinking cup or sports bottle
- \_\_\_ casual clothing for evening – must represent the church!
- \_\_\_ swim suit, cover-up, beach towel
- \_\_\_ plastic bag or laundry bag for dirty clothes
- \_\_\_ personal hygiene products
- \_\_\_ IPOD , MP3 for night time ***ONLY!*** Will not be allowed on work sites, at evening activities or @ worship.
- \_\_\_ carrier or bag for shower supplies
